- a meta evaluation of policies implemented in 7 European Member States

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Early School Leaving in Europe

- **5.6 Million** young people in Europe are early school leavers
 - These are **13.5 % of all 18-24 year olds in Europe** at heightened risk of poor labour market participation, poverty and social exclusion.
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- **EU 2020 target:** reduce ESL rate to 10% on average

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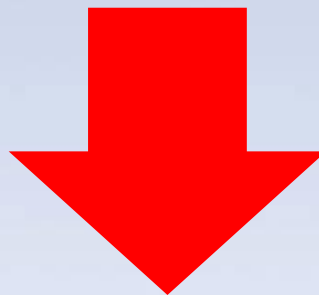

Problem focused

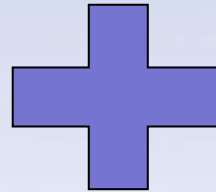

Data collection

Existing evidence:

- National level evaluations
- Policy documents
- Programme documentation
- Administrative data



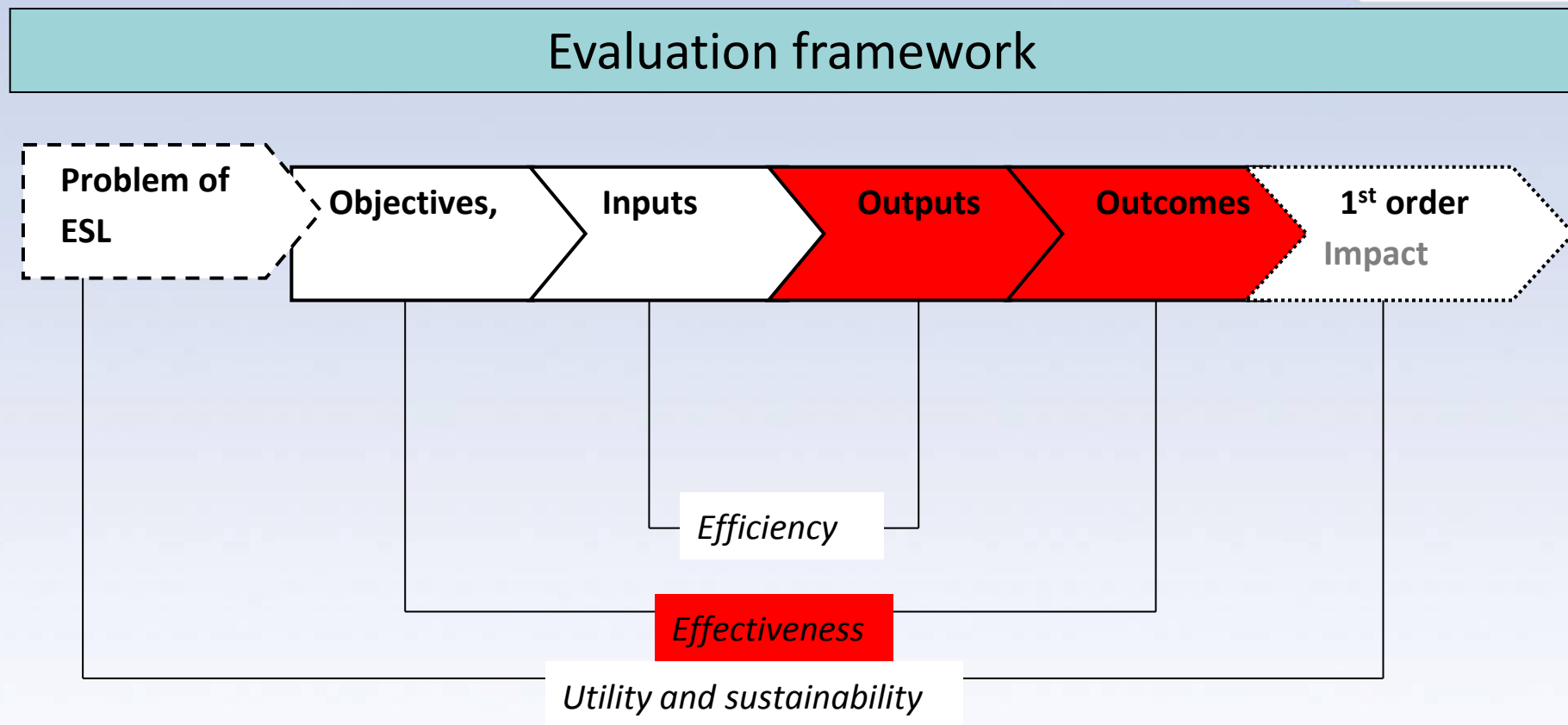
Triangulation:

- Stakeholder interviews
- Programme managers and 'critical friends'

Findings I

Output targets

- 5 policies with national level target, 2 local level, 1 without target
- In general, targets were reached and met the right target group
- Difference between preventative and reintegrative measures

Outcome targets

- Only 1 policy set quantitative targets
- Mixed evidence, lack of data



Policy pointers

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- Target those most in need
 - Foster self-responsibility
 - Tackle cultural change

Positives - learning insights

- Network of country analysts
- Triangulation / Complementing primary evaluations
- Identify policy pointers / common issues

Challenges - learning insights

- Focus on tackling policy issues
- Case and country selection?
- Quality of primary evaluations?
- Development of common framework?
