Early School Leaving in Europe

- **5.6 Million** young people in Europe are early school leavers
- These are **13.5 % of all 18-24 year olds in Europe** at heighted risk of poor labour market participation, poverty and social exclusion.
- EU 2020 target: reduce ESL rate to 10% on average

 Learning about the effectiveness of specified policies, here ESL Learning about evaluation practice and standards in different member states





Network of Country Experts




Triangulation:

- Programme managers and 'critical friends'

Output targets

- 5 policies with national level target, 2 local level, 1 without target
- In general, targets were reached and met the right target group
- Difference between preventative and reintegrative measures


Outcome targets

- Only 1 policy set quantitative targets
- Mixed evidence, lack of data
